Our EPO health plans with the Blue Priority network put you at the center of your care. These health plans also encourage Blue Priority in-network primary care physicians (PCP) to help prevent health problems before they happen. We provide these doctors with special tools, resources and data to help them give you personalized care based on your own health history.

What does this mean for you?

When you visit Blue Priority PCPs, you'll enjoy great health care and great savings through:

- Personal and coordinated care: Your EPO health plan with the Blue Priority network works best when you choose an in-network PCP. Blue Priority PCPs work with you to improve your health. They also can coordinate your care with specialists and hospitals. This way, you enjoy more personalized care and may avoid unnecessary visits and treatments, saving you money.
- *Meaningful information:* Your PCP will have access to your medical, prescription drug and lab data they need to make treatment recommendations based on a full picture of your health.
- *Greater access to doctors:* As a member, you can easily make appointments with in-network doctors. Plus, most of our in-network PCPs offer additional hours in the evening and on weekends.

We encourage you to find an in-network Blue Priority PCP. Just look at how much you can save when you do stay in-network:

You can easily find great doctors in 28 counties in New York.² If you're outside of New York, you can also access a broad network of hospitals and doctors through the BlueCard® program, including more than 96% of hospitals and 93% of doctors across the country.³
- What you need to do: If you haven't already, we recommend choosing an in-network PCP first. This doctor will get to know you and help coordinate your care going forward. Remember, having a PCP isn't required, but we highly recommend it. You'll enjoy more coordinated health care.
- What you need to know: You don't need a referral from a PCP to see a specialist. Just visit any one of our Blue Priority specialists and get lower-cost care by staying in-network. Your PCP can help you choose the right specialist for you.

It's simple and quick to find a great doctor nearby:

- 1. Log in to **empireblue.com** and under *Useful Tools* on the right, select **Find a Doctor**.
- 2. Select:
 - a. Insurance type Through my employer
 - b. Your state **New York**
 - c. Searching for Medical
 - d. Plan/Network Select your specific
 EPO Blue Priority plan. For example,
 select "Empire Gold Blue Priority EPO."
- 3. Select Continue.
- 4. Choose what kind of doctor you want to find.
- 5. Enter your location.
- 6. Select Search.
- 7. Next, your list of in-network doctors will appear.
